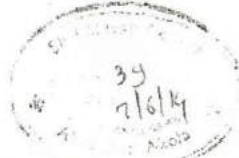



Chapter-1

Introduction

YDVD Art and Commerce College located at Teosa tahasil in Amravati District of Maharashtra. Teosa is tahasil or block in Amravati district. According to censuses 2011 information Sub District code of Teosa block is D4008. Total Area of Teosa 545 km². Teosa has population of 104728 people. There are 25429 houses in the sub district 92 village.

Selection of village :-

There are 92 village in Teosa district. Random Sampling Method use selection for village. There are five village selected for village and household survey. Their names are Shendurjan Bazar, Bharwadi, Warkhed, Satargaon and Wani. Unnat Bharat Project under taken to village and household survey.

Chapter-2

Location

Shendurjana Bazar, Bharwadi, Warkhed, Satargaon and Wani located at Teosa tahasil in Amravati district of Maharashtra.

Climate :-

Teosa tahasil has a tropical wet and dry climate with hot, dry summer and mild to cool winter. Summer lasts from March to June. Monsoon season from July to October and winter from November to

February. The highest and lowest temperatures ever recorded were 49.10C on 25 May 2013 and 5.0C on 9 February 1887.

Demography :-

Total area of Teosa tahasil 545 km². Teosa has population of 1,04,728 people. There are 25,429 houses in sub district 92 villages in Teosa block. Population density is 192 and sex ratio 946 in Teosa Tahasil in Amravati district of Maharashtra. Shendurjana Bazar population is 3000, Warkhed 1955, Wani 510, Satargaon 2258 and Bharwadi 881.

Education :-

Education facility in Shendurjana Bazar is Government Primary School available in village. In Bharwadi Government Primary School and Private Middle School. Middle School and Private Junior College facility available in Warkhed village. Government Primary and Middle school at Satargaon. Only Government Primary School available at Wani. All five villages available Anganwadi Kendra. Mostly student go to next education facility like Middle School, Junior College, Senior College for Teosa and Amravati City.

Migration :-

Main occupation is farming in all villages. This is dry Land Farming in village. In that farming get low annual income. So that migration become to Amravati and Nagpur to Searching work and job.

Water Facility :-

All five villages water table available at 15 feet. Averagely all families Pipe water facility at home. But hand Pump and open well facility not sufficiently available in village.

Drainage and Sanitation :-

Open drainage facility available in Sendurjana Bazar village. Swacha Bharat Abhiyan under toilet facility available every family at home. Open drainage link available in Bharwadi. But not available sufficiently toilet facility. People use go to open defecation. In Warkhed most family available toilet facility. Sufficiently toilet facility available at Satargaon and Wani.

Village infrastructure and Services :-

Primary Health Center, Post Office, Gas Agency, Fare Price Shop, Bus Stop, Playground are basic ammonites available in Shendurjana Bazar village, also available Pakka Road in village, Bus, Auto and own vehicle mode of transport, Panchayat Office, Community hall, Street Light, Social Organization and Electricity facility.

In Bharwadi village infrastructure and services are available Gas Agency, Fare Price Shop, Bus Stop, Play Ground, Panchayat Office, Community hall, Street light, Social organization and electricity facility.

In Warkhed village basic facility available is veterinary care Kendra, Bank, Post Office, Street Light, Pakka Road, Faire Price Shop, Bus Stop and Electricity facility.

In Satargaon village basic facility is available Primary Health Center, Post Office, Gas Agency, Fair Price Shop, bus Stop, Play Ground, Common Sanitation Complex, Grampanchayat Office, Community Hall, Street Light, Social Organisation and Electricity facility.

In Wani village infrastructure and services are Primary Health Center, Fair Price Shop, Bus Stop, Pakka Road, Transport facility like Auto and Own Vehicle, Gas Agency, Electricity facility available.

Agriculture Profile :-

Shendurjana Bazar, Bharwadi, Warkhed, Satargaon and Wani village agriculture profile is averagely 4 to 5 acre land holding to household. Largest level unirrigated farming in the village. Organic and chemical fertilizer use for agriculture production. This village agriculture production are soyabeen, toor, cotton and channa.

Government Scheme Converge :-

No more get benefit from government scheme to household. Only Shendurjana Bazar village Swacha Bharat Mission making toilet in household.

Livestock Asset :-

Livestock compliance low level in all adopted village. Because livestock compliance cost is high so that not affordable to household.

Chapter-3

Preparation of VDP

In Shendurajana Bazar total 300 family live in the village. Most OBC and SC category family live in the village. More than BPL household live in the village. Own houses but home in Kaccha Ghar. Open drainage link available to house, waste collection system is available at common point. Much more household available compost pit and biogas plant.

All category household life in Bharwadi village. APL and BPL household available in Bharwadi. High level kaccha house for

household. Many household not available toilet facility. They are go to open defection, open drainage link available to home. No available waste collection system. Compose pit and biogas plant not available to household.

More than OBC and SC category household live in Warkhed village. APL and BPL household both live in Warkhed village. Compost pit and biogas plant not available in home. Open drainage link available to home. Kutcha houses from many household.

Satargaon and Wani mostly people OBC and SC category and it is under APL and BPL category. It's own home but is braking into raw type. Open drainage link available to home. Compost pit and biogas plant not available in village.

Objectives :

1. To available basic infrastructure and amenities in village.
2. Frequency of available to transport to study.
3. To study Migrant status of family
4. To study government scheme benefit to household.
5. To review agriculture production and livestock compliance.
6. To increase rural people livelihood.

Methodology :-

Use of random sampling method for village survey and household survey. One third of the total household in each village are taken family survey. A total of 560 family have been served accordingly out of them 170 out of 500 families in Shendurjana Bazar 50 out of 150 families in Wani, 120 out of 400 family in Warkhed, 120 out of 300 family in Satargaon and 100 out of 300 families in Bharwadi in survey.

Chapter-4

Situation Analysis

The villages selected for the survey should benefit from the schemes of the Government of India as do not appear to have benefit much a large number of families come under BPL. The only source of income dry land farming. Traditional education facilities, migration in rural area is increasing. Increasing cost of animal husbandry so not developed dairy farming villages need to increase alternative employment and increase income to change the situation of people in rural area.

Chapter-5

Action Plan

Irrigation facilities need to be increased to the income of people in rural areas. This will facilitate per annual farming increase horticulture with cereals, orange, lemon, pomegranate, Peru, Custard apple and Amla etc. There is a need to increase technical education facilities to 10th and 12th class student as well as provide easy credit facilities to small technical business as this will create employment at the local level and reduce migration. In order to increase animal husbandry. It is necessary to provide expert guidance on how to reduce the cost of animal husbandry and also to implement animal husbandry development plan which will help in developing dairy business. If such action taken place in rural areas, people will be employed locally and will have the opportunity to increase income.

Chapter-6

Summary

Problems in term of employment and income in rural areas still do not appear to have improve not much. Providing employment and income generation opportunities to the rural people can improve the condition of the rural people and village.


