1.How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?



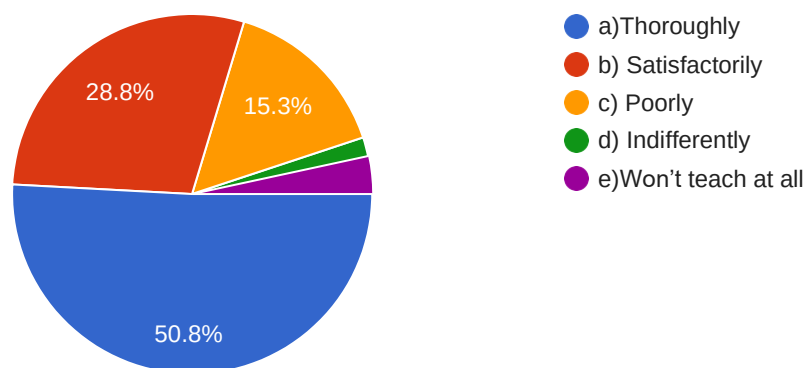

19) What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia, etc. while teaching?



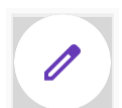
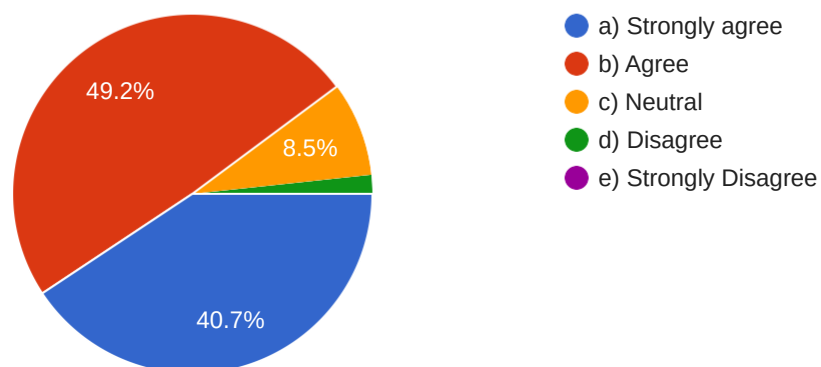

SSS Analysis and Action Taken Report

2022-23

1. Syllabus Coverage:

- Most respondents indicated that below 30% to 85-100% of the syllabus was covered.
- Action: Review the curriculum pacing and teaching methodologies to ensure better coverage. Conduct periodic assessments to gauge syllabus coverage and adjust teaching plans accordingly.

2. Teacher Preparedness:

- Responses varied from "poorly" to "thoroughly prepared."
- Action: Provide additional training and support for teachers who are rated poorly prepared. Encourage sharing of best practices among faculty members.

3. Communication:

- Responses ranged from "very poor" to "always effective."
- Action: Organize workshops or seminars on effective communication skills for teachers. Foster an open communication environment where students feel comfortable expressing concerns.

4. Fairness of Evaluation:

- Views ranged from "very fair" to "sometimes unfair."
- Action: Implement transparent grading criteria and assessment methods. Ensure consistency in grading across different courses and instructors.

5. Teaching Approach:

- Most respondents rated the teaching approach as "excellent" or "very good."
- Action: Continue promoting effective teaching methods and encourage innovation in pedagogy. Provide resources for implementing student-centered approaches.

6. Mentoring and Feedback:

- Responses indicated that feedback on performance and mentoring were generally provided.
- Action: Strengthen the mentoring system by ensuring regular follow-ups and constructive feedback sessions. Encourage mentors to address both academic and personal development needs of students.

7. Use of Technology:

- Majority of respondents reported a high usage of ICT tools.
- Action: Continue supporting the integration of technology in teaching. Offer training sessions to faculty members on advanced technology tools for enhanced teaching effectiveness.

8. Overall Quality:

- Most respondents rated the overall quality of teaching-learning process positively.
- Action: Acknowledge the areas of strength and continue fostering a conducive learning environment. Address any identified areas for improvement through targeted interventions.

9. Suggestions for Improvement:

- Some respondents provided specific suggestions like better graphics, engaging visual media, and reaching out to every student for doubt clarification.
- Action: Evaluate and implement feasible suggestions to enhance the teaching-learning experience. Encourage ongoing feedback from students for continuous improvement.
